Innovation Hills Park - Rochester Hills

The three-acre nature themed playground located at 2800 W. Hamlin Rd, offers several elements to keep children of all abilities entertained for hours. There are also elements that will enhance your child's vestibular motion skills. In addition to the climber, the playground area includes swings, climbers, and an astro-turf hill for sledding. There are two sensory gardens on the property. One is maintained and designed by local students, while the other is professionally maintained. Both provide guests with beautiful and fragrant flowers throughout the seasons.

Children's Play Farm at Inglenook Park - Southfield

Located at 20901 W. 12 Mile Rd in Inglenook Park, Children's Play Farm is a Boundless Playground that includes a **Sway Fun Glider** and consists of farm-themed play equipment, including tractor bouncers, animal cutouts and enormous playscape with a combination of rubber and wood fiber safety surfacing.

Delta Mills Park

Delta Mills Park located at 7001 Old River Trail in Lansing offers accessible playground equipment (please note there is small path of woodchips leading up to the play structure), a picnic shelter, nature trails, sports facilities, and more! The park is also proud to announce the brand-new non-verbal communication board!



Maple Beach Playground at Kensington Metropark - Milford

Located within Kensington Metropark, the Milford Maple Beach Playground is open year round, offering a play structure that prioritizes safety and inclusivity. The play area also offers quiet spaces for independent play and a variety of climbing elements and swings for children of all abilities to enjoy.

Lodge Playground at Marshbank Park - West Bloomfield

Located at 2805 Hiller Rd, Lodge Playground at Marshbank Park offers a ramping system, <u>Landscape Structures' PlayBooster</u> play structure offers unique play experiences with many sensory play panels, bridges, slides, and climbing elements. Children of all abilities are able to play in this inclusive play space.

ANYbodies Playground - Battle Creek

All abilities are welcome at the ANYbodies playground, a boundless playground inside Bailey Park. This totally fenced in park offers multiple slides, a sandy area, swings, a toddler area, individual play areas, and more!

Dad Butler Playfield - Detroit

Located at 2034 E. Eight Mile Rd., The Dad Butler Playfield is a barrier-free play area. The playground has climbing structures, slides, and swings, and is located adjacent to soccer fields, baseball diamonds, and a picnic area.

Longfellow-Summerfield Play Area - Flint

Longfellow-Summerfield playground is a boundless playground offering an opportunity for children of all abilities to learn together through play. **NOTE**: The surfacing of this park is a mix of pour-in place rubber and wood mulch which may make it more difficult for individuals using a wheelchair to maneuver around the playground.



The New Buffalo Welcome Center Playground - New Buffalo

The New Buffalo Welcome Center's "Able to Play" is a boundless playground offering a play area for children of all abilities with a rubberized surface and lots of play options. This playground is also completely fenced in and just a short walk from the parking lot.

Lamar Park & Splashpad - Wyoming

At nearly 75 acres, Lamar Park located at 2561 Porter in Wyoming features a picnic area, sporting facilities, and an accessible walking trail. Lamar Park is also home to Splashpad, a universally accessible splashpad featuring soaker stations, water tunnels, and more! Aqua chairs are also available for free with advanced reservation for individuals with mobility challenges to enjoy.

Let Them Play Playground - Friendship Park - Lake Orion

Friendship Park in Lake Orion is home to multiple playgrounds and the Miracle League of North Oakland field, a picnic shelter, accessible restrooms and more! Dragon's Den is an ADA compliant play structure recommended for children ages 5-12 years old. Coming soon, "Let Them Play" playground in Friendship Park will feature a 100% wheelchair accessible playground equipment for individuals of all ages to enjoy.
