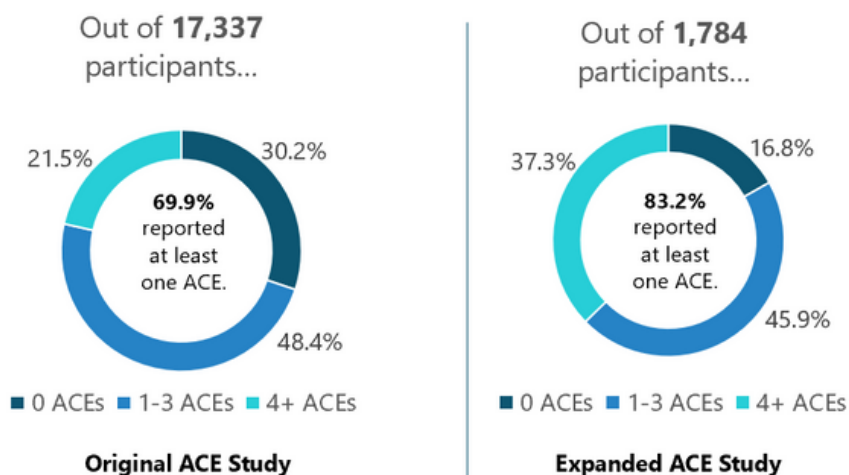




ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES WORKSHOPS

When children are exposed to adverse and stressful experiences, it can have a long-lasting impact on their ability to think, interact with others, and on their learning. Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) are any traumatic events that occur before an individual turns 18 and can impact their future (ex. future violence, victimization, lifelong health, and opportunity).

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT TO LEARN IN THE WORKSHOPS?



Individuals in attendance can expect to:

- Learn how to recognize ACEs and trauma responses within ourselves
- Identify how those responses might affect future generations
- What we can do to prevent the continuation of the cycle
